# Addenda, Corrigenda et Commentarii Inscriptionum III

## 1. A Weight from Magnesia ad Maendrum: Marcus Aurelius Artemidoros

O. ΤΕΚΙΝ published a weight from the İzak Eskinazi Collection three years ago<sup>1</sup>. The weight most probably originated from Magnesia ad Maeandrum bears two countermarks and a controlstamp. But the inscription of the control stamp was not published in this publication. According to our reading from photo follows as:

Control Stamp

Μ(ἄρκος) Αὐρ(ήλιος) Ἀρτεμίδωρος ἀγορανόμος.

Countermark A

A

Countermark B

Μα(γνησίων).

It was already known from an inscription from Ephesos<sup>2</sup> that a certain M. Aurelius Artemidoros had performed the functions of gerusiastes, neopoios and agoranomos. The inscription on this weight evidences once more that M. Aurelius Artemidoros served in the role of agoranomos as described in the honorary inscription from Ephesos.

The the weight is dated after 212 AD because of Aurelius gens.
